



## **Policy Expo**

It is an event where policies related to Daejeon and Sejong are intensively discussed, and new policies are discovered to be reflected in city administration.

### **Signing Business Agreements**

## **Basic Research**

The city's mid- to long-term policy vision and policy development, as well as basic research to strengthen the capabilities of researchers

## Strategic Research

Research projects in response to changes in the domestic and international environment or through interdisciplinary collaborations centered on issues, visions, and current events

## **Current Issues Research**

Short-term tasks such as issue review, screening, and policy advisory in response to requests for collaboration from the cities or related agencies and in-house research

## **Policy Research**

Long-term, systematic policy development or research that is requested by other organizations on current issues or deemed necessary by the Institute


### **Joint Research**

## **Offices**

## Office of Planning and Coordination

The office prepares and coordinates research projects, chooses projects and assesses outcomes, engages in public relations, produces publications, manages archives, and organizes academic events and research exchange projects.

#### **Urban Information Center**

By building a database specific to Daejeon and Sejong, developing indicators, and monitoring them, the Urban Information Center assists Daejeon and Sejong in securing the logic required to formulate and promote policies. It also plays a role in quickly and accurately supplying information to Daejeon and Sejong.

## Economic and Social Research Division

The office conducts a wide range of studies on women, families, welfare, culture, and tourism to enhance the quality of life for the residents of Daejeon. Additionally, it researches and analyzes local financial, budgetary, and human resource management strategies of local administrative bodies and gives projections. It also studies local economic growth and industrial promotion policies.

## Spatial&Environmental Planning Division

The office undertakes research to plan, discover, and professionally assist urban planning, transportation planning, and environmental planning policies in order to produce sustainable urban development and new spatial environments.

## Department of Sejong City Policy Research

The office performs policy research for the Sejong Special Self-Governing City and the Sejong Metropolitan Area, which includes creating innovative policies, identifying important concerns, and investigating present issues.

#### Sejong City Balanced National Development Support Center

The center was established under the ordinance on the establishment and operation of the balanced national development support center in Sejong city. This center is an organization supporting Sejong, the leader of balanced national development, in policy research and issue management for Sejong to be born as future strategic capital city, and cooperate for the growth as a practical administrative capital city.


## Office of Administration and Finance
